Sibel Erduran is Professor of Science Education at University of Bristol, UK and Visiting Professor at Kristianstad University, Sweden. She is the Editor of International Journal of Science Education, Section Editor of Science Education, and serves on the editorial board of Review of Educational Research among other journals. She is currently the NARST International Coordinator. She has authored close to 130 publications and made 120 international/national presentations including plenary speeches at conferences in Taiwan, South Africa, Korea, Argentina, Turkey and Lebanon. She completed her higher education in biochemistry, food chemistry, science education and philosophy at Northwestern, Cornell and Vanderbilt Universities in the USA, with financial support from the Fulbright Commission and Spencer Foundation. She was an educational researcher at University of Pittsburgh and King's College, University of London, and taught high school chemistry and middle school science in a secondary school in northern Cyprus. She is the recipient of the NARST best paper award as well as a range of grants including those from the Economic and Social Research Council, Training and Development Agency for Schools, European Union, and Gatsby Foundation. Her research interests broadly concern the inclusion of perspectives on the nature of scientific inquiry in science teaching and learning.
